

VILLAGE OF SCHILLER PARK – LICENSE COMMITTEE MINUTES OF 8/1/2016

Call to Order:

Chairman Fritz called the meeting to Order at 6:00 p.m.

Roll Call:

Approval of Minutes

Motion by Gorzynski, second by Fritz, to approve the 6/13/16 minutes as presented. Passed

Public Comment:

No one to be heard.

Old Business:

1) Alcoholic Beverages Ordinance Review

Committee and staff reviewed the Attorney's memorandum that included suggested amendments to Chapter 110 of the Code of Ordinances. There was extensive discussion with consensus as follows:

- 110.10 Definitions – Better define gambling as conventional to distinguish this activity from video gaming, which is permitted. This is a clarification for Section 110.59
- 110.32 Ineligibility – Delete reference to residency in Schiller Park as a criteria for license holders.
- 110.59 Prohibited Conduct – Delete fashion show exception for private parties. Delete restriction on dancing. Prohibit conventional gambling. Delete prohibition on video gaming.

Attorney Abel asked Village Clerk Irsuto to send any adopted ordinance amendments to American Legal Publishing with a request for both the paper and website to be updated.

Motion by Gorzynski and second by Fritz to recommend the passage of an ordinance with amendments as previously identified. Passed.

2) BASSET

Director Tison said the State requires that direct servers and over-the-counter sellers be trained. He has completed the training. Attorney Abel referenced the cooperative sting earlier this year in which State Liquor Commission investigators and Schiller Park Police found over half of the 15 tested establishments failed an underage solicitation. Manager Townsend said this underscores the need for BASSET.

Assistant Rosario recommended that Police Officer Klug be at an upcoming meeting to discuss details.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:54 p.m.
