Approved minutes from the April 2018 meeting.

Discussed:

- Village Board adopted BOH budget for Fiscal Year 2018-19 at \$9,260 for programs and stipends.
- BOH members may need to be proactive if they really care about amending the Dog and Cat Ordinance.
- Hearing and Eye (diabetic retinopathy) testing bus is scheduled for 7/24/18. Pat is working on this.
 - Should draft promotional message for Village email news flash and website.
- Health Inspection summary record reviewed for first quarter; January through March 2018.
- LEPH notified Village that the FDA Code requires more extensive and longer inspections. Fees are up.
- Village newsletter changing from traditional bi-monthly to special releases, website, and Facebook.
- Leyden Township can provide animal traps upon request.
- A generator provides emergency power to Village Hall. Can serve as warming/heating shelter.
 - The generator at the Community Center is no longer functional and parts will be sold.
 - Lincoln School serves as the alternative warming and cooling shelter.
- A total of 34 units collected at 4/17/18 Life Source blood drive. Next event will be on 6/19/18.
