

VILLAGE OF SCHILLER PARK – PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MINUTES OF 5/24/16

Call to Order: Chairman Rick Desecki called the meeting to Order at 6:16 p.m.

Roll Call: Present: Trustee Desecki, Trustee Fritz, Trustee Klug

Also in attendance: Mayor Barbara Piltaver, Trustee Robert Lima, Village Manager Brad Townsend, Assistant Village Manager Brian Bursiek, Public Works Director Eric Oscarson, Interim Community Development Director Eric Tison, Village Engineer Patrick Glenn, GIS Analyst Alissa Pump and Tom Thomey of MGP, plus floodplain project engineers Jeana Gowin, Don Dressel, and Mike Burke of Christopher B Burke Engineering, Ltd.

Discussion:

Village Manager Brad Townsend said the purpose of this meeting is to present study results related to a Proposed New Flood Plain Map – Crystal Creek. He introduced Village officials, professional consultants, and Village staff in attendance.

Engineers from Christopher B. Burke Engineering, LTD. presented their finding from the study of the drainage improvements to Crystal Creek. This included a presentation of the engineering projects that were completed leading up to this study. Presentation included the proposed changes to the flood plain map and timeline expected for implementation of the new map. Village Engineer Patrick Glenn noted that the total number of parcels or lots would be greatly reduced from 630 to 223; a reduction of 407.

Alissa Pump from MGP, Inc., shared the slide map that her team put together that is available on the Village website. This will allow residents to view their property before and after the revisions to the map.

Questions were fielded from the audience by Christopher Burke staff and the Village Engineer, Patrick Glenn regarding:

- Floodway v. Floodplain
- Home located half in/out of floodway
- Notification of meeting updates
- Flood insurance changes
- Elevation Certification Costs

Assistant Village Manager, Brian Bursiek discussed that the GIS maps and floodplain maps are available of the Village website.

Village Engineer, Patrick Glenn explains expected timetable for implementation.
