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*Proposed Public Notification for Floodway Revision, with other Flood Hazard Changes
FEMA Case No. 17-05-6422P
Village of Schiller Park
March 27, 2018*

The Villages of Franklin Park and Schiller Park and the City of Chicago, in accordance with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) regulation 65.7 (b)(1), hereby give notice of the intent to revise the floodway located along Crystal Creek, Sister Stream, Motel Tributary, Industrial Tributary and Sexton Ditch.

Specifically,

- Crystal Creek floodway shall be revised from River Road in Schiller Park to approximately 1,820 feet upstream of Mannheim Road in Chicago. As a result, the floodway shall narrow with a maximum narrowing of 318 feet approximately 160 west of Scott Street in Schiller Park.
- Sister Stream shall be revised from its confluence with Crystal Creek, located immediately downstream of Irving Park Road in Schiller Park, to approximately 90 feet west of I-294 in Franklin Park. As a result, the floodway shall narrow with a maximum narrowing of 444 feet 780 feet southwest of the intersection of Wehrman Avenue and Irving Park Road in Schiller Park.
- Industrial Tributary floodway shall be revised from its confluence with Sister Stream, located at the northeast corner of I-294 and Belle Plaine to approximately 590 feet west of Transworld Road, all in Schiller Park. As a result, the floodway shall narrow with a maximum narrowing of 186 feet 190 west of George Place in Schiller Park.
- Motel Tributary floodway shall be revised from its confluence with Industrial Tributary, located immediately west of I-294 to 1,960 feet south of Belle Plaine Avenue, all in Schiller Park. As a result, the floodway shall narrow with a maximum narrowing of 132 feet at the southwest corner of Belle Plaine Avenue and I-294 in Schiller Park.
- Sexton Ditch floodway shall be revised from its confluence with Sister Stream, approximately 90 feet south of Seymour Avenue in Schiller Park, to approximately 50 feet west of the northwest intersection of Panoramic Drive and Dora Street in Franklin Park. As a result, the floodway shall narrow with a maximum narrowing of 120 feet at the northwest intersection of Panoramic Drive and Dora Street in Franklin Park.

In addition, the 1% annual chance water-surface elevations and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall be revised for each of the affected watercourses at the limit extents described above, except for Sexton Ditch, which shall be revised from the confluence of Sister Stream to approximately 860 feet west of northwest intersection of Panoramic Drive and Dora Street in Franklin Park. As a result of this revision, the 1% annual chance flood water surface elevations shall decrease and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall narrow for a majority of the revision area.
