What You Need To Know!

The Census Is Needed!

The Village of Schiller Park, its residents and businesses, will benefit greatly from a complete and accurate Census count. The Census is used to determine the number of representatives we have in Congress and in the General Assembly. The Census data is used to distribute \$675 billion in federal funds each year to support vital programs in states and communities across the country. These funds shape local health care, housing, education, transportation, employment, and more. **If we are undercounted, Schiller Park may not get the level of federal funding we need.**

The Census Is Convenient!

For the first time you will be invited to respond to the Census online (including on your mobile device). You can also respond through the mail or by phone. In mid-March, residents will receive a mailing outlining the convenient online process. The mailing will contain an important unique address code to utilize when responding online. You can also attend the Village's 'Census Night' at the Library (see below). If there has been no response from a residential address, census workers will begin going door-to-door this summer.


The Census Is Safe!

The Census Bureau has taken extraordinary steps to prevent hacking of their system and to make sure your information is secure and your personal privacy is protected. Your information is NOT shared with other agencies, including law enforcement, the FBI or ICE. They will never ask for your Social Security number or any financial information.

The Census Is Easy!

The questions are brief and simple.

- Total number of people living in your household, including any additional people who may be staying with you
- Do you own or rent
- Name, sex, age and date of birth of all in household
- Are you of Hispanic, Latin or Spanish origin
- Phone number
