Dear Village of Schiller Park Resident,

**Beginning August 1st, 2020, the Village of Schiller Park will be changing its solid waste services contractor.** The new service contract will allow residents to receive all new refuse and recycling two-wheeled carts. The Village has awarded Flood Brothers Disposal the contract to provide solid waste services in a manner similar to what is now in place with Waste Connections/Groot. The enclosed welcome packet from Flood Brothers outlines the services to be provided to all single-family, two and three-unit, properties within the Village, including what will remain the same and what services will be expanded.

Each residential unit will receive one (1) 95-gallon refuse cart and one (1) 65-gallon recycling cart over the last two (2) weeks of July. Your service schedule will be adjusted to a new day, **THE NEW COLLECTION DAY WILL BE TUESDAY**, this will be for refuse, recycling and yard waste.

Additional refuse, recycling and yard waste that will not fit into the cart will be accepted. Flood Brothers offers additional carts to residents for a monthly rental fee direct to the resident. Residents are asked to follow the criteria for proper placement of carts detailed in the collection booklet. Residents will continue to be allowed bulk item pick-up each week free of charge. Collection of white goods and Do-It-Yourself home projects will be collected as outlined in the booklet. The FREE electronics waste collection will still be provided through the Village behind the Public Works garage, in the Village parking lot. In addition, Flood Brothers will offer electronic recycling curbside collection for a fee.

Flood Brothers will begin the transition during the last couple weeks of July, residents may have an overlap of both companies' carts. Waste Connections/Groot will begin to remove your current containers on your last scheduled service day (July 31st). The cart removal process may take multiple days. Please leave your Waste Connections/Groot carts at the curb until it is removed.

**Flood Brothers will begin the Tuesday collection on August 4th, 2020.**
