NEW BUSINESS

Director Cremin informed the Board Members that we are moving forward with putting together a plan to open the pool but that is dependent on staffing. The pool season will be different this year and will be on a reservation system with a maximum of 50 people per 2 hour time slot and will be offering three 2 hour time slots per day, with a half hour cleaning break between each session. There will be no concessions this year. Patrons will be requested to bring their own chairs to reduce the amount of cleaning and sanitizing required and temperatures will be checked based on CDC guidelines. The Village will change the fee structure to a "per session fee" and refunds will only be issued if the Village closes the pool due to inclement weather or another unforeseen circumstance. This is necessary because of the limited pool capacity and "no-shows" prevent another resident from using the pool.

Rocco Pretzie, Board Member and Youth Baseball League Manager informed the Board Members that we currently have 51 kids registered in the various Youth Baseball programs and this is the highest enrollment we have to date. Rocco Pretzie stated that the Schiller Park Youth Baseball/Softball League is in the West Suburban division. Rocco announced the Youth Baseball/softball Opening Day event will include the teams' parade to the field followed by a rededication of Shelton Field. The date of the event has not yet been set but is currently being planned for either the weekend of April 24 or the first weekend in May.

Director Cremin informed the Board Members that the Easter Parade will be held on Saturday, April 3 and kick off time is 10:00 a.m. at Village Hall. Director Cremin invited the Recreation Board Members to attend and be on a truck in the parade. She stated it will be roughly a three-hour event and if anyone is interested to please let her know.
