General Information

VILLAGE HALL is open Monday through Friday, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Saturdays 9:00 AM to Noon unless otherwise stated.

BUILDING PERMITS are required for all types of construction. Online permitting is available on the Village Website. Check in with Community Development BEFORE work is started. No electrical equipment can be installed or altered without a permit. Plumbers and roofers are required by law to be licensed with the State of Illinois.

CURFEW FOR MINORS requires anyone under the age of 18 to be off all public areas by 10:30 PM Sunday thru Thursday and by 11:30 PM on Friday and Saturday, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian, performing duties, or lawfully employed, making it necessary to be out at such times.

PET LICENSES & TAGS are required for all dogs and cats and must be attached to the pet's collar, together with proof of a rabies shot. Pet tags are valid from July 1st thru the following year until July 31st, and are available at the Village Hall: \$5 each, \$7 after July 31st.

LEASH LAW: Dogs and cats are required to be on a leash when off the owner's property, except when at the Bark Park. When walking a dog on property other than the owner's, a proper pet waste receptacle bag is required and must be visible and utilized.

GARBAGE & RECYCLING is removed EVERY Tuesday by a commercial disposal company contracted by the Village. Garbage and Recycling receptacles should be out on the public parkway or alleys with handles facing the home. During the weeks of Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Christmas and New Year's Day, garbage will be picked up on Wednesday if the holiday falls on a Sunday, Monday or Tuesday.

PARKING is permitted on residential streets unless otherwise prohibited by ordinance. Signs in the parkways will indicate parking restrictions. Parking of trucks with "C" plates or above is prohibited.

SCOOTER LAW In the interest of Public Safety, the Village of Schiller Park only permits the operation of E-bikes or E-scooters by individuals who possess a valid drivers license who are also 18 years of age or older.

PARKING & SNOW REMOVAL begins after 1 inch of snowfall; street parking on both sides of the road is prohibited until the streets have been cleared. Snow removed from walks or drives should NOT be deposited on plowed streets. When shoveling your driveway, please pile snow on parkway.

REGISTER TO VOTE: Residents must be registered to vote in elections. You can register online at ova.elections.il.gov when renewing or applying for your state ID or driver's license, or in person at Village Hall. One picture ID, along with an additional form of identification, showing your current address is necessary for in-person registration.

SOLICITING: If a solicitor is aggressive to the point of being a nuisance, call the police at 847-678-4794. Solicitors must comply with all Village ordinances, State of Illinois regulations and laws pertaining to soliciting. Schiller Park performs background checks on solicitors and gives them a badge/ID which must be displayed when soliciting in the Village. The Village provides "No Solicitor" decals for your convenience.

STREET SWEEPING begins in early April and continues until late November. To allow the sweeper to clean the curbs and gutters, parking is restricted on the day sweeping will occur. Check street signs for the days of sweeping and parking restrictions.

VEHICLE STICKERS for passenger and RV plates are \$20. "B" plates are \$45. Stickers are available beginning May 1st. The deadline for purchasing and displaying your sticker is on July 31st, after which the cost will double. Prices for truck vehicle stickers vary with the size of the truck. Vehicles housed in Schiller Park MUST have a vehicle sticker. Each licensed driver over 60 can receive passenger vehicle stickers at no cost.

YARD WASTE includes grass clippings, twigs, shrubbery, dead flowers and plants. Collection begins on the first Tuesday in April and ends on the last Tuesday in November. There are two methods of curbside disposal: Utilize a 30 gallon or smaller generic biodegradable paper bag, or designate a 32 gallon capacity (or less) can for landscape waste only. Yard waste cans must display a printed "YARD WASTE ONLY" sticker (available at the Village Hall). Any bag/can containing mixture of yard waste and other trash will NOT be picked up. Bundled and tied tree branches, using biodegradable twine, no longer than 4 feet in length can be placed on the parkway for pick up. Do not put leaves or grass clippings in the street. Flood Brothers is the Village vendor for garbage, recycling, and yard waste.
